The Global Wind Organisation (GWO) sets the international standard for safety training and emergency procedures in the global wind industry. All personnel in the wind industry are required to complete the minimum level of basic safety training which includes:

- ❑ GWO Working at Height
- ❑ GWO Manual Handling
- ❑ GWO First Aid
- ❑ GWO Fire Awareness
- ❑ GWO Sea Survival

Career pathways

The wind industry offers a wide range of exciting career opportunities, from transport, installation, and logistics to operations and maintenance.

While some jobs are office-based, many are hands-on roles out in the field, either onshore or offshore. Salaries in this industry can vary depending on the role and the company you work for.

Competitive salaries

If you're just starting out, a common entry-level role is on construction sites in positions known as pre-assembly or construction.

Some may begin their careers offshore as wind technicians, responsible for installing, maintaining and repairing wind turbines. According to job site Indeed, newly qualified wind technicians can earn between £22,000 and £40,000 per year.

Transferable skills

These roles are ideal for people who enjoy hands-on work and spending time outdoors. If you have transferable skills, like experience in electrical or mechanical work, it can be a big plus.

Employers also look for individuals with a strong work ethic and other versatile skills. Look out for companies who offer apprenticeship programmes each year as this provides a great way to get started.

£60,000 annually

With experience and further training, wind technicians can progress into senior roles such as lead technician, site supervisor, or even project management positions.

According to Glassdoor, wind site supervisors in the UK can earn up to £60,000 annually.
